

Over the last quarter we made voting recommendations at 148 meetings (1,510 resolutions). At 80 meetings we recommended opposing one or more resolutions. We recommended voting with management by exception at three meetings and abstaining at one meeting. We supported management on all resolutions at the remaining 64 meetings.


Developed Asia

We recommended voting against or abstaining on 35 resolutions over the last quarter.




